**OUR PROGRAMS PROVIDE:**

- A safe structured treatment environment
- Psychiatric evaluation
- Physical examination
- Medication Management
- Individualized treatment plan
- Individual and group therapy
- Family sessions that include caregiver support and education
- Activity therapy
- Individualized discharge and aftercare planning
- Lunch and snacks provided daily
- Local transportation available if needed

*Individuals will be admitted into the program based on an intake assessment.*

**ADOLESCENT PROGRAM**

- 13-17 years old
- 8:00 am - 4:00 pm Monday through Friday
- Average length of stay is approximately 3 weeks, but may vary according to each patient's needs.
- Patients are provided an educational/academic component during the treatment day to promote being integrated back into school programming without being overwhelmed. Classes are taught on-site by a Louisiana Certified Teacher.

**ADULT PROGRAM**

- 18 years and older
- 8:30 am - 3:00 pm Monday through Friday
- Average length of stay is approximately 3 weeks, but may vary according to each patient's needs.

**SENIOR CARE PROGRAM**

- 55 years and older
- 9:00 am - 1:30 pm beginning at 3 days per week and dropping to 2 days then 1 day as the patient progresses through treatment.
- Average length of stay is approximately 8 weeks but may vary according to each patient's needs.

**PROBLEMS COMMONLY ADDRESSED BUT NOT LIMITED TO:**

- Emotional/Behavioral problems
- Mood/Anxiety disorders
- Substance Abuse/Dependency issues
- Self-Destructive behaviors
- Adjustment issues
- Anger and/or impulsivity issues
- Difficulty functioning at home or school
- PTSD
- Relationship conflict
- Gender specific issues
- Grief
- Abuse/trauma
- Military specific issues



**BOARDING/LODGING SERVICES FOR ADULTS**

- Available option for clients living outside the Shreveport/Bossier area
- All meals, snacks, and local transportation provided while in program

- Prior approval required
- Lodging will be held at a local hotel Monday through Thursday nights
- Client to return home on the weekends to spend time with family and friends
