PATIENT RIGHTS: CHILDREN UP TO 12**

You have the right:

1. To be treated fairly and with respect.
2. To receive help in the safest place.
3. To tell us who we can call in an emergency.
4. To a medical doctor to help your medical problems including pain.
5. To be involved in making choices in treatment.
6. To know the names of staff and what they do at the facility.
7. To talk on the phone at scheduled times and to mail letters (unless the doctor tells you why you can't)
8. To have visitors at scheduled times.
9. To report abuse or neglect (1-855-452-5437).
10. To wear your own clothes unless staff and/or your doctor find that they are not safe.
11. To keep your information at the facility private.
12. To ask staff for help in solving legal problems.
13. To write or make a complaint.
14. To attend religious groups at the facility. If you don't want to go staff cannot force you.
15. Not be treated different from others related to your race, color, religion, gender/sex, sexual orientation, national origin, age or disability.
